BB-EFC Missionary of the Week - BB-EFC Missionary of the Week - Will and Julie White with Mission Aviation Fellowship in Nampa, Idaho, write that Will went with MAF's Disaster Response Team to help with the hurricane disasters in Dominica and Barbuda. Over 80,000 pounds of tarps, water systems, hygiene kits and emergency food were flown in by Samaritan's Purse. Will was asked to fly the Suriname plane for a 4-week rotation to fly SP staff and volunteers daily from Antigua to Barbuda and back because Barbuda had been evacuated by local authorities and help had to be flown in and out daily.
